Dates to Remember

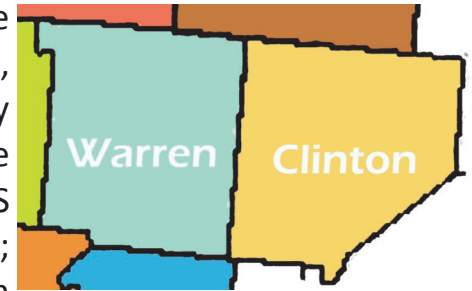
June 26—Adela Dingman Retirement Party from 2-4 in Commissioners Meeting Room.
