# During Fire inspections - BDAs need to be <u>verified</u> that they are registered!

Many schools and businesses are installing BDAs or "Building Distribution Amplifiers" that pull signal from the County radio towers into the building, amplifying portable radio signal. This improves first responder safety when inside your buildings! Correctly installed BDAs are designed with internal batteries to keep the system operating even if the power to the building is cut off.

Because the BDA operates on the same frequencies as the County towers, the building owner must obtain permission from the County to operate the BDA. Further, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) requires all BDAs be registered. Building owners can do this at <a href="https://signalboosters.fcc.gov/signal-boosters/">https://signalboosters.fcc.gov/signal-boosters/</a>



Because the BDA is a life safety device, *all BDAs should be included in the fire inspection process* and the batteries replaced every 5 years. Because the signals from BDAs can be harmful to the County radio system, it is important that 24/7 emergency contacts be obtained during the registration process in the event a BDA is causing interference to the radio system and needs to be turned off / repaired.


