Bi-Annual Radio System Upgrade



Part of our radio system includes an upgrade every other year that keeps us state of the art and current with the latest systems being built and shipped

around the country. We anticipate our system going into site trunking some days which is more disruptive to dispatchers than end users. Site Trunking = our county's 9 towers get disconnected from the rest of the state. If you are in Warren County when Site Trunking begins, local talkgroups work as normal and you'll only notice issues if you leave range of our towers. If you're out of the county when site trunking begins, (e.g. on TAC 3 in Butler County), you won't hear people talking on TAC 3 if they're associated to a Warren County tower. There's essentially a barrier around our County separating us into a standalone system like when on our analog system.

Motorola will also be upgrading the Dispatcher consoles to Windows 10 which may affect auto toning. There is a lot of work scheduled and lots of precaution taken in case of problems.
