

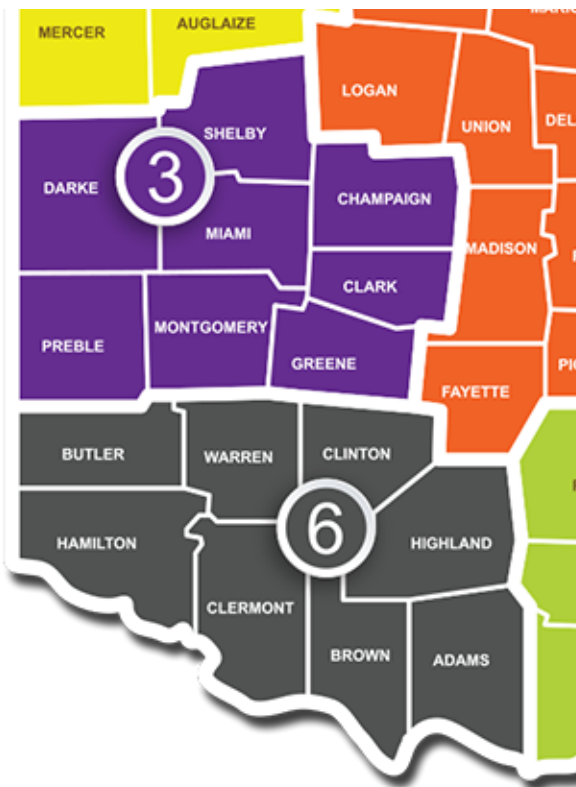

Know Your Radio: HSR3 MCI & HSR6 MCI talkgroups

Intended Audience: Communities in Homeland Security Regions 3 & 6

What are HSR3 MCI & HSR6 MCI used for?



“In order to facilitate the orderly evacuation of patients in a mass casualty incident, the [HSR3 MCI and MSR6 MCI] talkgroups were created to coordinate the movement of patients to medical facilities with available capacity. All hospitals in the region are able to give available bed counts to net control during an incident. EMS units are directed to the closest, and best facility, with the capacity to take their patient.”

—Regional Tactical Interoperable Communications Plan 1.3.5 (RTICP)

Where to find it in your radio

Talkgroup location varies by county and agency. Ask your radio programming for a radio template if not already provided.

Potential talkgroup locations based on the RTICP 1.3.5

- Warren County Agencies: positions 14-16 of the Hospital zone. Download your template from <https://telecom.co.warren.oh.us/TrainingCommunication/RadioTrainingTemplates.aspx>
- Butler County: position 12 & 13 in your hospital zone
- Hamilton County: position 11 & 12 in lower fireground zone
- Montgomery County: position 12 & 13 in zone R3HOSP2
