


, Intended Audience: Law Enforcement + Fire/EMS Mobile Enterprise Users

Previously known as address flags, caution notes are attached to specific address points, block ranges, or phone numbers and appear under the CAUTION tab on your F1 View Dispatch / My call screen. The accuracy of caution notes depends on agencies reporting to Dispatch via radio or phone when one no longer applies or when one needs added. The Warren County Emergency Communications Center maintains a Caution Note Validation process, providing lists of addresses to police/fire/ems agencies to verify.



Dispatch does not verbalize these. Units must look at the Caution Note tab.

- long lay driveways,
- knox box codes,
- door access codes,
- vicious dogs

Dispatch verbalizes over radio.
Appears as yellow tab & ribbon

- addresses with persons known to make threats to first responders,
- large ammunition/explosive/ chemical caches.
- Private property bridge weight limitations

When creating a Caution Note, Dispatch will choose the highest severity category in which it could fit. E.G. "subj is EDP and known to carry weapons" fits both Medical/Mental and Weapon, but Weapons would be the category due to the higher threat.

Categories: Unknown, Knox Box/Access Info, Location Info, Medical/Mental, Vicious Animal, or Weapons.

Incident with No Caution Notes (hidden & grayed out)

Mobile Enterprise will hide tabs with no information. Clicking the ... reveals the grayed out CAUTION tab with 'No Available Information' written below.
